Leave it to the professionals

Be Prepared

- ✓ Use only legal fireworks from licensed outlets.
- ✓ Always read and follow label instructions.
- ✓ Set up a bucket of water or have a hose nearby.

Be Safe

- ✓ Use fireworks on outdoor paved surfaces far away from buildings, cars, & shrubs.
- ✓ Never aim fireworks at buildings, cars, people or pets.
- ✓ Never alter fireworks or make your own.
- ✓ Never pick up or try to re-light a "dud."

Be Responsible

- ✓ Only adults should light fireworks.
- ✓ Store fireworks, lighters, and matches out of the reach of children.
- ✓ Dispose of used fireworks in metal containers and douse them with cold water.

Please Remember:

Fireworks are only allowed on July 4th from 9 a.m. to 11:59 p.m.
within Fire District 7 boundaries. Fireworks are BANNED in the city of Mill Creek.
